

Chapter 4 – Academic Affairs

BP 4100 Graduation Requirements for Degrees and Certificates

References:

Education Code Section 70902(b)(3); Title 5, Sections 55060, et seq., BP 3255

Mt. San Antonio College grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science to those students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have maintained a 2.0 average in subjects attempted.

The residency requirements for Mt. San Antonio College will be 45 units in residence or 12 units and the last semester in residence. Students must also complete the general education and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.

Students may be awarded a Certificate of Program Completion upon successful completion of courses of study or curriculum for which Mt. San Antonio College offers a certificate. The College has certificate programs that upgrade and develop career and technical proficiency.

The College President/CEO in consultation with the Academic Senate shall establish procedures to determine degree and certificate requirements and to assure that graduation requirements are published in the College's catalog(s) and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
